6. School improvement plan update:

- a. Provincial assessment results: The RW3, M4, and RWM6 Nova Scotia assessment results were suspended due to the pandemic last school year. As a result we were not able to examine progress of develop cohort comparisons. Hopefully next year we will see a continuation, so as to continue the collection of this important data.
- b. Principal suggested a change to the current math goal. Thanks to observations of classroom teachers, it is recommended that we change the focus of our math goal from Problem solving to number sense and partitioning. Problem solving will remain a focus, but will be addressed during maker space and math stations.
- b. The principal reported on the development of the school contingency plans around the potential for partial school closures, or full learning from home scenarios.
